





'Dw i'n dod o....' – 'I come from'

The following letters on the left will change to the letter shown alongside on the right below.

For the Level 2 test, you will only need to learn how to say where you are personally from. Have a look at the table above, to see what the start of that place name would mutate to.

*e.g. I come from Denbigh – 'Dw i'n dod o **Dd**inbych'*

You don't need to mutate English or foreign place names
e.g. I come from Birmingham – Dw i'n dod o Birmingham
